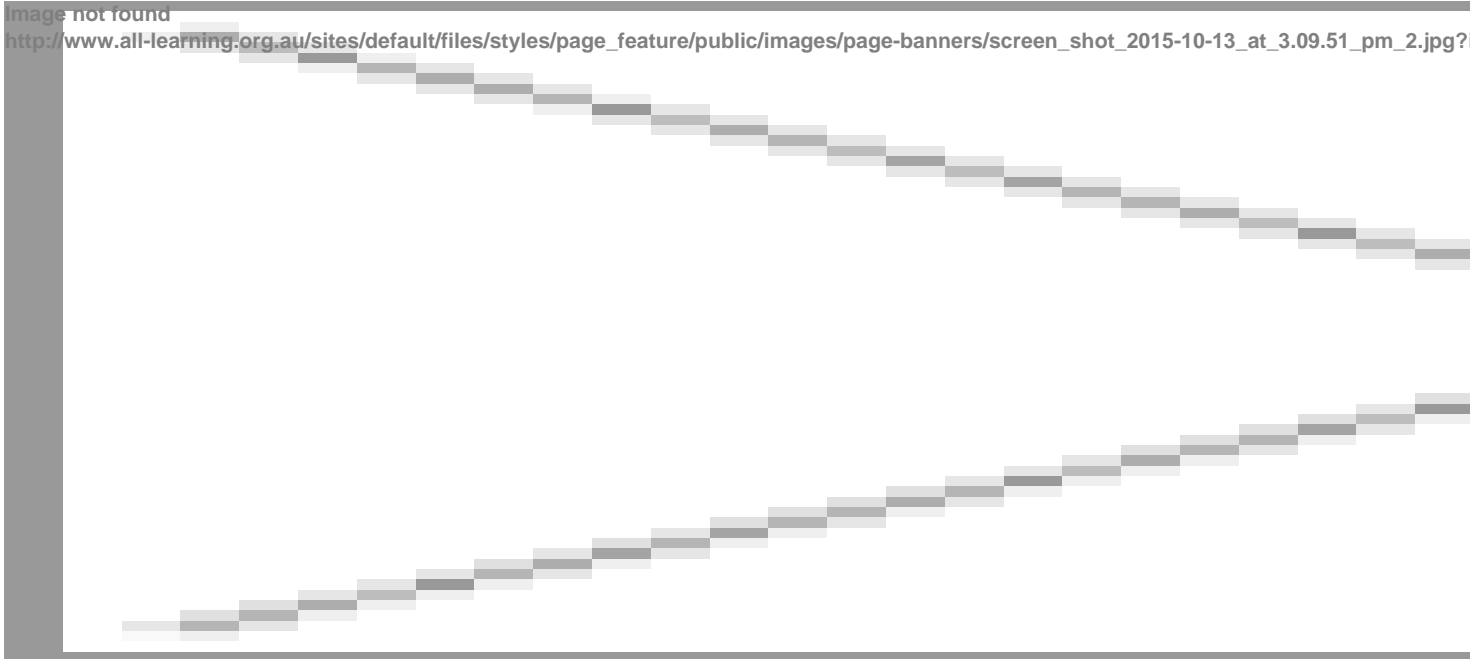


Collaborative Problem Solving: Screening and Q&A ^[1]
